Notes

- 1. RAAs and DRAAs should not normally **concurrently** hold offices with major responsibilities to hospital trusts, or directly managed units. (e.g Medical Director, Clinical Director, Chairman of a department of Anaesthesia or ICM) Previous experience in such roles is useful and is viewed positively.
- 2. Those who seek to hold RAA or DRAA posts while also being a Head of School or TPD should consider carefully:
 - the potential for conflicts of interest, in delivering training while being responsible for its quality management. Their application should outline how they would seek to minimise this potential conflict.
 - the time commitment needed to fulfil each role to its maximum potential.

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
