

SAFE Programme Lead Role description

Purpose of the role

This is a voluntary role, jointly appointed by the Association of Anaesthetists (the Association) Foundation and WFSA, to lead implementation of the SAFE strategy and programme delivery. As part of this appointment the role holder will be the Chair of the SAFE Steering Group.

This appointment will commence 1 October in 2021 as a successor to Dr Isabeau Walker, Foundation Trustee and SAFE Board Lead.

- With the WFSA programmes team, lead communications relating to SAFE, both internal and external, including periodic updates to the IRC and the WFSA Education Committee
- Receive and review course reports with SAFE Topic Leads
- Liaise with SAFE Operating Room Steering Group
- Work with the Association and WFSA fundraising teams to develop grant applications for SAFE
- Develop annual plans and budgets with the Association and WFSA management teams
