- Guidelines for the Provision of Anaesthesia Services for ENT, Oral Maxillofacial and Dental surgery
- Guidelines for the Provision of Angesthesia Services for Vascular Procedures
- Guidelines for the Provision of Regional Anaesthesia Services (new chapter).

GPAS chapters support anaesthetists with responsibilities for service delivery and healthcare managers to design and deliver high quality anaesthetic services.

With the exception of Guidelines for the Provision of Regional Anaesthesia Services which is a new chapter being developed, the remaining GPAS chapters mentioned above were originally published in 2019 and are undergoing a full review. It is anticipated that the GPAS chapters will be published in January 2024.

What does being a CDG member involve?

As a member of the CDG you will be required to provide feedback to the respective GPAS authors on draft recommendations and attend at least one CDG meeting via Microsoft Teams (dates to be confirmed). The majority of correspondence will take place via email. As a CDG member you will be acknowledged in the final document.
