THE PURPOSE

The purpose of the College Tutor Representative on the MTI Leadership Group is to take an active role in the development and running of the MTI scheme in Anaesthesia, Intensive Care Medicine, and Pain Medicine.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- To provide advice, guidance and support to MTI doctors, MTI Hosts, the International Training team, and external organisations on all issues relating to the MTI scheme
- To engage fully with the activities of the MTI Leadership Group
- To act as the Clinical Lead for the 'New to the NHS' event and actively participate in other MTI related events
- To promote the MTI scheme to College Tutors and wider audiences
- To lead the development and delivery of an annual MTI Alumni report, in conjunction with the International Training team
- To lead the development of an MTI Regional Champions network, in conjunction with the International Training team
- To give full and fair consideration to equality and diversity whilst ensuring that the integrity of the MTI scheme is upheld
- To uphold the vision and values of the RCoA
- To draw any matter of concern to the attention of the Chair of the MTI Leadership Group.

COMMITMENT

The role holder will be expected to commit to at least four meetings per year and more frequently if the workload so requires. The role holder will also be expected to commit an average of three hours per week to International Training activities.

The normal term of office will be three years, renewable for a further three years. Further extension may be granted at the discretion of the Chair of the MTI Leadership Group.
