Clinical and Anaesthetic Sciences Exam

What is CASE?

CASE will replace the current OSCE SOE, with an anticipated launch in the academic year 2027 – 28, subject to successful piloting and approval from the General Medical Council.

The proposed format for CASE is a series of short, 5-minute stations and longer, 10-minute stations. This pilot will focus on the **long** stations.

Why participate?

- Be part of the development process of this significant examination.

- A complimentary sandwich lunch will be provided, and standard travel expenses (rail/bus fares) will be reimbursed.
