- 1. **INFORMATION** Copies of the regulations, on-line exams registration, application forms and candidate information sheets can be found and downloaded from the College website www.rcoa.ac.uk.
- 2. APPLICATIONS Candidates are asked to note the following:
 - (a) Online application and payment must be completed by 5pm on the closing date. Paper applications must reach the Examinations Department not later than 5pm on the closing date shown in this calendar. Late applications will be rejected. TEE Applicants must be verified with the College at least three calendar months before the starting date of the examination applied for.
 - (b) Applications and payment for exams can now be submitted on-line using the OLS exams icon available on the Exams pages of the College website. Alternatively applicants can use the application form and cheque payment system: Completed application forms must be accompanied by the fee and any appropriate certificates required by the Regulations (Read the candidate information sheet that accompanies the application form). The College only accepts cheques drawn on a UK clearing bank, sterling drafts or postal orders. Cheques must be made payable to "The Royal College of Anaesthetists" and crossed. With the exception of those candidates provisionally accepted on a "fill up" basis all cheques will be cashed on receipt.
 - (c) The On-line exams system will close at 5pm on the published closing date. Complete and correct application forms together with the appropriate fee must be received by 5pm on the closing date. No application in any form will be accepted after 5pm on the closing date.
 - (d) Acknowledgements, by email, are sent to applicants on completion of the on-line process and on receipt of application forms. Admission forms bearing Candidate Number and instructions are sent by email around 5 working days after the closing date.
 - (e) Candidates who withdraw before the closing date will receive a refund of their examination fee, subject to a deduction of £40 for administrative expenses if withdrawal is after 14 days of payment of the exam fee.
 - (f) Refunds to candidates who withdraw after the closing date will only be considered where the reason for withdrawal is beyond the control of the candidate, such as illness or family related issues and is granted at the discretion of the Head of Examinations.
- 3. Applying and sitting: In the Primary FRCA examination candidates must pass the MCQ paper before applying to sit the OSCE/SOE sections. At the first attempt the OSCE and SOE components must be taken at the same sitting. If a candidate passes either the OSCE or the SOE but fail the other component then he/she can apply to re-take the failed component, without having to retake the one that was passed. In the Final FRCA examination candidates must pass the MCQ and SAQ paper (the written exam) before applying to sit the SOEs.
- 4. **PAST PAPERS** Past SAQ papers may be downloaded from the Examinations pages of the College website (www.rcoa.ac.uk). MCQ papers are not released but, the "Guide to the Primary FRCA" and "Guide to the Final FRCA" (each priced £26, see calendar for overseas costs), contain sample questions from all sections of the exam and can be ordered from the Finance Dept. of the College 020 7092 1584.
- 5. **RESULTS** Candidates should note that no results will be given by telephone. A list of Pass/Fail in the Primary examinations and the Final examinations will be published on the College website, using Candidate Nos. only. All results will be confirmed in writing to the address supplied t the College.
