



Giving Anaesthesia Safely Again Return to Work Simulation Course Wednesday 23 June 2021

Returning to work in anaesthetics after a period of time away, for example due to maternity leave, research or experience in a different speciality can be daunting. The Royal College of Anaesthetists and Academy of Royal Colleges recommend support for those away for greater than 3 months. This course is aimed at those who have had a break of 3 months to 2 years and will provide strategies for managing your return to work and will build confidence. There will be the opportunity to practice clinical scenarios in the simulator, as well as workshops and short talks to review key areas and signpost updates in clinical practice. It is delivered in a supportive environment and complements keep in touch days or workplace support.

We will provide a course booklet with relevant algorithms, articles and references. Participation is recognised for RCoA CPD but is not a sign off for return to practice. The course has limited spaces to enable individualised scenarios catering to the grade of anaesthetist with plenty of time for discussion.
